- Our space is limited, so register early! Registration may be capped for space.
- We will be offering single entry only on the website. If you have students who wish to double-enter, please send me a separate email with the students' names, original registered event, and the event they wish to double enter. If space allows in existing sections, we will approve double-entry. Please note that we are using two different buildings, and this may impact whether or not students can double-enter certain events. I will let you know if the double-enter requests have been approved or not by Wednesday.

Entry Fees:

Entry fees will be \$5.00 per student. If a student is double entered, they will be charged for both entries. Fees may be paid on tournament day, or will be invoiced with proper PO documentation.

We will be using the 2019-2020 MHSA rule book for B/C events.

(Extemp Draw will be 30 minutes prior.)

Prelim rounds will be held at Sweet Grass Co. High School and Big Timber Grade School. All Finals rounds will be held at the High School. The buildings are approx. 6 blocks apart. (Statistically, there is a good chance it will be very windy!) Teams are responsible for transporting their own students between schools.

Parking:

Buses at the High School: Students may offload at either the Office door or the Gym door. Please park on the West side of the parking lot.

Buses at the Grade School: Students may offload on Anderson Street at the Front door. Please park along 5th Avenue, Harris Street, and 6th Avenue (the playground).

Concessions:

Student Commons will be in the Gym in both schools. Concessions will be available at the High School for lunch for students in the Cafeteria (adjacent to the Gym). Standard concession options (hot dogs, hamburgers, chili, candy, soda, popcorn, etc.). Additional offerings may be available for sale in the mornings. (Muffins, juice, etc.)

Food and drink will be available for judges, coaches, bus drivers in both schools in the morning, and lunch offerings will be available at the high school in the afternoon.
