Eligibility

This tournament is unrestricted, so technically anyone of the appropriate grade level can enter the tournament regardless of experience; however, many of our competitors will have limited debate experience. In the future we will attempt to separate by both grade level and by experience. Currently we do NOT have a “novice” division.

For this tournament, there will be three “open” debate completion levels:

Elementary (grades 4-6), **Middle School** (grades 7-8) and a **High School Division** (grades 9-12).

Registration:

1. Enter your school's teams using <http://www.forensicstournament.net/>
2. Entries must be submitted by 5pm, October 3, 2016. Any drops or substitutions must be submitted by 5pm, October 5, 2016.
3. Early registration is encouraged, because there is a limited number of rooms available, so we must prioritize on a "first-come, first-served" basis.
4. **Double entries will not be allowed.**

NSDA Rules

NSDA Rules for Public Forum Debate will be followed, except for whatever has been contradicted in this invitation, the tournament website, or the information packet written for this tournament. The format is considered a “crossfire” style, yet debating will be a bit more academic in focus rather than attempting to imitate the popular news program.

Debate Rules

Public Forum Debate: We will follow NSDA rules: 4-4-2-2 with 2 minutes of preparation time.

Lincoln Douglas Debate: We will follow the standard high school NSDA rules: 6-7-4-6-3 with 4 minutes of preparation time.

Impromptu Speaking

Up to six speakers per classroom. Each speaker will be given a different set of quotations. The speaker will then have 2 minutes to prepare their speech and then 5 minutes to speak (total 7 minutes). You may use more time to prepare but it will take away from your speaking time and could reduce your score. The goal is to speak for the entire 5 minutes.

Evidence is Encouraged!

Students are allowed to bring ANY research materials with them and are allowed to read from printed materials.

As per the tournament invite, this is a tournament that uses the public forum topic and the public forum format but with a more academic focus than is typical. Thus, the expectation is that in-depth, evidence-based debates SHOULD occur, but teams are not encouraged to just read pages of evidence without providing some context or organization to their speeches. Source citations should be similar to school. ***Electronic Retrieval is Restricted, but not Banned.*** ***Do not access the internet during the debate round;*** this includes cell phones, calling friends, etc. The majority of your research should be done before the tournament. During lunch and any ‘down’ or ‘free’ time it is permissible to do some research online.

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Parking

Parking is available in the parking lot on campus. Lot #5 will be easy to access to the debate room. Parking fee is \$5 per car per day. Purchase the permit from the machine at the entrance of parking lot #5. Be sure to clearly display the parking permit on the dash of your car.

IMPORTANT: Vehicles must be parked normally (do not back into a space or pull forward into another space - there is a fine for irregular parking at IVC).
