



The CAL Tournament will have a special pattern for video submission of Original Narrative and Cultural Artifact speeches. Students can register for this event by registering in Pattern B. This event will follow the same guidelines as the Original Narrative and Cultural Artifact speeches presented in person at the tournament. The purpose of allowing video submissions is to give students the opportunity to obtain experience with mediated communication and allow students who cannot attend the tournament a chance to participate. Students may enter a video Original Narrative submission and CA speech and also enter the in-person event on October 8. Use of the same Original Narrative speech and CA speech is permitted.

Winners will be announced on Oct 8 at the awards ceremony for the CAL Tournament 1 at CSU Fullerton.

Videos are due by Oct 3rd.

Videos can be uploaded to YouTube or Vimeo but **must** be shared with ACLAForensics@gmail.com on or before October 3rd.

In the video details you must include the student's name and academy's name.
