RULES:

LINCOLN-DOUGLAS VALUE DEBATE: We will use the 2010 January/ February NFL Topic and use OSAA rules.

PUBLIC DEBATE: We will use OSAA rules. Students may only use a dictionary to prepare their cases. 15 minutes prep. Students will prep in their competition rooms.

PUBLIC FORUM DEBATE: We will use OSAA rules. The January 2010 Public Forum Topic shall be used.

JUDGES:

Each team must provide 1 coach available to supervise students and judge throughout the tournament.

Each judge covers 6 IE entries and 2 Debate entries
