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Tournament Guidelines

AFA-NIET rules will be followed in the participation and tabbing of all individual events.

Students may enter a maximum of three events per pattern. Semifinals will be held in all events with 45 or more entries, and finals will be held in all events. The patterns are:

Pattern A: DI, EXT, PER, POE, PRO

Pattern B: ADS, CA, DUO, IMP, INF, POI

Debate will follow IPDA, NFA, and NPDA guidelines. NPDA will be offered on Friday and Saturday. IPDA will be offered Friday and continue through Saturday. NFA-LD and Team IPDA will be offered Sunday. Students who participate in NPDA, IPDA, TIPDA, or NFA-LD may not concurrently register for IEs on the day those debate types are offered.

Registration for IE's will take place on Speechwire.com. Registration for Debate will take place on forensicstournament.net. Preliminary entry is due by Tuesday, February 6, 2017 at 5:00 p.m. Drops or changes may be made until 12:00 noon, Wednesday, February 7, 2018.

Fees

Individual Events: \$10 (*one judge covers 8 slots*)

NPDA Teams: \$50 (*one judge covers 2 teams*)

IPDA: \$30 (*one judge covers 4 debaters*)

TIPDA: \$40 (*one judge covers 2 teams*)

NFA-LD: \$20 (*one judge covers 2 debaters*)

Miscellaneous Fees

Uncovered IE entries: Fee + \$10

Uncovered NPDA entries: Fee + \$50

Uncovered LD: Fee + \$20

Uncovered IPDA: Fee + \$30

IE Drops at tournament: Fee + \$20

NPDA Drops at tournament: Fee + \$20

LD Drops at tournament: Fee + \$20

IPDA Drops at Tournament: Fee + \$20

All IE judges are expected to be available for final rounds. Debate judges are expected to be available for one round past when their teams are eliminated.

Awards

All IE finalist and debate elimination round contestants will receive awards.

For each IE tournament, sweepstakes awards will be given to the top 3 schools and top 3 pentathlon speakers.

Pentathlon eligibility requires students to compete in 5 events, which must include at least one interpretation event (DI, DUO, POE, POI, PRO), one public address event (ADS, CA, INF, PER), and one limited preparation event (EXT, IMP).

In debate, the top 3 speakers in each division of IPDA, NPDA, and LD will receive awards. The top 3 schools will also win awards. For team debate sweeps, only the top four entries in each division of debate will count towards the award.

For both IE and debate, the top 3 competitors that compete in both areas of competition will be recognized. The top 3 overall schools in IE and debate during the swing will also be recognized, as well as the top community college and top program from Oklahoma. To calculate overall team awards, the percentage of total points in earned in IE's plus the percentage of total points earned in debate will be utilized as the determining factor in ranking these programs.

1 st place – 6 points	Each LD or TIPDA prelim ballot won - 3 pts
2 nd place – 5 points	Each IPDA or NPDA prelim ballot won - 2 pts
3 rd place – 4 points	Each elim ballot won (any debate) - 2 pts
4 th place – 3 points	
5 th place – 2 points	
6 th place – 1 point	
7 th place/non-advancing semi-finalist – 0.5 point
