

A Bill to Require High Schoolers to Pass a Fake News Literacy Class

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1. High schoolers shall learn how to differentiate fake news from real news. Students also need to pass this class in order to graduate from High School.

SECTION 2. The requirement will be applied to all High Schools within the United States.

SECTION 3. The U.S Department of Education shall oversee the enforcement of this bill.

SECTION 4. This legislation shall take effect on the start of the 2020-2021 school year.

SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Provide WiFi as a Public Utility

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1 **SECTION 1.** The United States shall provide free WiFi for those on US property
2 with no extra charge.

3 **SECTION 2.** WiFi service shall only be provided within the United States and its
4 territories. Wifi providers such as T-Mobile, Verizon, and AT&T will
5 work together to provide the country with free WiFi. Telecom
6 companies will be offered a government contract. This will be done
7 by building more satellite cell towers across the nation.

8 **SECTION 3.** The Federal Communications Commission shall oversee the
9 enforcement and implementation of this bill.

10 **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall take effect January 1, 2023.

11 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and
12 void.

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A Bill to Reduce Prison Overcrowding & Assist in the Rehabilitation of Convicted Criminals

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** Federal prisoners convicted for non-violent and/or victimless crimes
3 be granted the option to provide professional services for which
4 they are qualified to the public free of charge, and/or serve in the
5 United States Military to reduce time off of their sentences.

6 **SECTION 2.** This applies to only to convicted federal criminals.

7 **SECTION 3.** A. Inmates which test positive for any communicable diseases will
8 not be permitted to serve in the US Military.

9 B. Inmates convicted of violent crimes or demonstrating violent
10 behavior during while serving their sentences will not be permitted
11 to participate in this program.

12 **SECTION 4.** This bill shall take effect on October 1st, 2020.

13 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and
14 void.

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A Bill to Ban Animal Testing

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1. All animal testing in the U.S. is prohibited.

SECTION 2. . Animal Testing shall be defined as the use of non-humans in experiments that seek to control the variables that affect the behavior or biological system under study. Being deemed a waste of money, using \$16 billion of taxpayers' money.

A. It is unlawful for any company to sell a product if it was tested on an animal.

B. This applies to the manufacturer or any supplier or retailer of the manufacturer.

SECTION 3. The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) shall oversee the enforcement of this bill.

SECTION 4. This legislation shall take effect on January 1st, 2022.

SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Enact The Cactus Protection Act of 2019

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1 **SECTION 1.** All domestic physical and online nurseries selling cacti native to the
2 United States are required to apply for FWS form 3-200-55 at the
3 cost of \$200 for each business.

4 A. At brick and mortar nurseries, the approved FWS permit
5 must be physically displayed.

6 B. Online nurseries must provide a copy of their approved
7 FWS permit on each sale delivered.

8 **SECTION 2.** All international trade and sale of cacti native to the United States is
9 prohibited.

10 **SECTION 3.** The US Department of the Interior will oversee the enforcement of
11 this bill.

12 A. Domestic violators of this legislation shall be subject to a
13 ban on sale and growing of native cacti for 10 years and fines
14 starting at \$10,000.

15 B. Domestic growers caught selling internationally shall be
16 subject to a ban on sale and growing of native cacti for 15 years
17 and fines starting at \$25,000.

18 C. 50% of each application fee and monies collected in
19 penalties will be used to fund research and rehabilitation of cacti
20 native to the United States.

21 **SECTION 4.** This shall take effect on February 14, 2020.

22 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and
23 void.
