Lincoln-Douglas Debate: Resolved: States ought to eliminate their nuclear arsenals.

Policy Debate: Resolved: The United States federal government should substantially reduce Direct Commercial Sales and/or Foreign Military Sales of arms from the United States.

Public Forum Debate: Resolved: The United States should replace means-tested welfare programs with a universal basic income.

Judging Requirements:

Each participating school or organization is being asked to supply 1 judge per 2 entries. Judging names and cell phone numbers should be submitted at the time of registration. If you need to register judges but don't know their names yet, please use your school name with a number to indicate the judges you will be providing (i.e. Wilshire judge 1; Wilshire judge 2; etc.). \$20 uncovered judge fee for Congress. \$75 uncovered judge fee for Debate.

Hired that do not conflict with any team/school should be noted so that they can be used as a clean judge for all competitors.
