

A Bill to Terminate Weaponry Sales to the Saudi Government

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** The United States Federal Government will cease any arms sales
3 involving Saudi Arabia.

4 **SECTION 2.** Arm sales include but are not limited to weaponry, armored
5 vehicles, and aircraft.

6 **SECTION 3.** The U.S. Department of State's Bureau of Political-Military Affairs
7 (PM) and the National
8 Security Council (NSC) are responsible for the implementation of this legislation.

9 **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall be implemented in January 2021.

10 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and
11 void.

A Bill to Illegalize Vehicle Manufacturers from Producing Gas-Powered Cars and Switch to Electric-Powered Cars or Hybrids

BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1: All vehicle manufacturers creating gas-powered vehicles in the United States must convert to producing electric cars or hybrids to reduce pollution.

SECTION 2: This bill only applies to the United States and its territories. Current gas-powered vehicles will be converted to electric cars or hybrids by adding an internal combustion engine using an electric motor and batteries to decrease the amount of greenhouse gases released into the atmosphere.

SECTION 3: The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration shall oversee the enforcement and implementation of this legislation.

SECTION 4: This legislation shall take effect on January 1, 2025.

SECTION 5: All laws in conflict are hereby declared null and void

Preliminary Round Legislation

A Bill to Fund the Immigration Courts to Aid Unaccompanied Immigrant Minors

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1. The Immigration Courts will receive an additional \$5 million in funding each year to run more efficiently in order to aid unaccompanied minor immigrant children cases.

SECTION 2. \$5 million will be cut from the military budget

SECTION 3. This legislation will be enforced and overseen by the Office of Management and Budget to ensure that courts have the proper resources.

SECTION 4. This bill shall take effect on January 1, 2021

SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

Final Round Legislation

A Bill to Permanently Extend the Corona Stimulus Package

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1. The United States shall permanently give \$1,200 per month to each individual 18 years and older who annually make \$75,000 or less, or couples who make \$150,000 or less. An additional \$500 will be provided per child in the household.

SECTION 2. This payment will decrease on a sliding scale for those earning between \$75,001 and \$98,999 or married couples making between \$150,001 to \$149,999.

SECTION 3. The Federal Reserve shall enforce this legislation and implement a .03% Value Added Tax on goods and services

SECTION 4. This bill shall take effect on April 16, 2021

SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

Final Round Legislation

A Bill to Ban Foreign Telecommunications Companies

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1. All foreign telecommunications companies are hereby banned from selling their products or equipment to U.S. consumer, business and government entities.

SECTION 2. Any U.S. entity with any other business relationship (e.g. supplying parts) to the aforementioned companies will be subject to review by the Committee on Foreign Investment in the United States (CFIUS) on an annual basis after this legislation has gone into effect.

SECTION 3. The Department of Commerce will be responsible for enforcing this legislation.

SECTION 4. This bill will go into effect November 4, 2020.

SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
