

A Resolution to Increase Funding for Nuclear Power

- 1 **WHEREAS,** *Nuclear Power is only 20 percent of the US energy supply*

A Bill to Encourage Uniforms in Public Schools.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1. **SECTION 1.** The United States government will give extra funds to public schools that enforce a uniform policy.
2. **SECTION 2.** In order to receive the funds, public schools must enforce the dress code policy on 90% of school days. Schools will be permitted to use up to 90% of the funds awarded to subsidize the cost of uniforms for families that cannot afford them.
3. **SECTION 3.** This bill will be enforced by the U.S. Department of Education. The funds will be generated by reducing funding to underperforming charter schools.
4. **SECTION 4.** This legislation will take effect on August 1st, 2022.
5. **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Enforce Voting By Mail

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1. Voting by mail will be the primary and only way to vote in the U.S

SECTION 2. The mail will be sent for every county 7 days before election day

SECTION 3. The Federal Election Commission will be responsible for the implementation of this legislation

SECTION 4. This legislation shall be implemented on November 3, 2020

SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation is hereby declared null and void
