

The 2021 SCJFL 4th Quarter Elementary School Tournament Legislation #1

A Bill to Increase Funding for NASA

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** The United States shall double the funding of the National Aeronautics and
3 Space Administration (NASA) from \$23.3 Billion USD to \$46.6 Billion USD for the purpose
4 of the administration's goal of human exploration.

5 **SECTION 2.** "Human Exploration" shall be defined as expanding human presence into
6 the solar system and to the surface of Mars to advance exploration, science, innovation,
7 benefits to humanity, and international collaboration.

8 **SECTION 3.** The Implementation of this bill shall be overseen by the Congressional
9 Budget Office (CBO) in coordination with the Department of Defense (DoD).

10 **A.** All means of funding shall be allocated from the United States Military Budget.

11 **B.** The withdrawal and implementation of funding should be set in a maximum
12 time span of 10 years.

13 **SECTION 4.** This law shall go into effect in the beginning of Fiscal Year of 2022.

14 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

The 2021 SCJFL 4th Quarter Elementary School Tournament Legislation #2

A Bill to Construct Wildlife Crossings

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** The United States shall build 2,000 new wildlife crossings through all 50
3 states by 2025, with focus on areas with high populations of endangered terrestrial
4 species.

5 **SECTION 2.** Wildlife crossings will be defined as an underpass or overpass constructed in
6 relation to a multi-lane highway that is covered in vegetation to allow for safe animal
7 crossings.

8 **SECTION 3.** The Department of the Interior and the Department of Transportation will
9 oversee the construction of these crossings.

10 **A.** The Department of Transportation will oversee the construction of these
11 crossings.

12 **B.** The Fish and Wildlife Service will ensure that the crossings have the
13 components necessary to be safe for wildlife.

14 **SECTION 4.** Construction will begin on January 1, 2022 and will be completed by
15 December 31, 2025.

16 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

The 2021 SCJFL 4th Quarter Elementary School Tournament Legislation #3

A Bill to Limit Gene Editing Technologies

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** CRISPR and other Gene editing technologies may only be used on medical
3 patients in the event of a life-threatening disease or one that seriously impedes
4 the quality of the patient's life.

5 **SECTION 2.** Life threatening diseases are defined as:

6 A. Impairment of physical bodily functions.

7 B. Disease involving substantial risk of death.

8 Individuals have the right to accept or refuse care, and provide advance directive for
9 care.

10 **SECTION 3.** The department of Health and Human Services will oversee the
11 implementation of this bill.

12 **SECTION 4.** This will go into effect in January 2022.

13 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

The 2021 SCJFL 4th Quarter Elementary School Tournament Legislation #4

A Bill to Restore the Voting Rights of Former Felons

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** The voting rights of former felons are to be restored.

3 **SECTION 2.** Voting rights are defined as the right to vote in a government election.
4 Former felons are defined as someone who has served their sentence and
5 are no longer under a form of correctional supervision such as probation
6 or parole.

7 **SECTION 3.** The United States Election Assistance Commission and the United States
8 Department of Justice that will oversee the enforcement of this bill.

9 **SECTION 4.** This bill will take effect on January 1, 2022.

10 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

The 2021 SCJFL 4th Quarter Elementary School Tournament Legislation #5

A Bill to Institute a Nationwide Ban on Hydraulic Fracking

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** The federal government shall hereby enact a nationwide ban on hydraulic
3 fracking.

4 **SECTION 2.** Hydraulic fracking shall be defined as the process in which water, sand,
5 and chemicals are pumped underground in order to release natural gas. This bill shall
6 grant federal oversight of fracking in all federal environmental regulations that exclude
7 oil and gas companies.

8 **SECTION 3.** The Department of the Interior, specifically the U.S. Environmental
9 Protection Agency, shall oversee this legislation.

10 A. Any oil and/or gas company found in violation with this legislation shall be
11 fined \$500,000 for every occurrence and shall be subjected to federal prosecution.

12 B. Any monetary value received shall be donated to the Department of the
13 Interior.

14 **SECTION 4.** This legislation will take effect on September 1, 2021.

15 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
