

## **A Bill to implement Universal Background Checks on all gun sales to decrease gun violence**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:**

2 **Section 1:** All prospective gun buyers would have to undergo a  
3 national background check before the sale whether or not the  
4 sale is public or private.

5 **Section 2:** Universal Background Checks would be classified as  
6 requiring all firearm purchasers, public and private, to pass a  
7 criminal records check done nationally by the Federal Bureau of  
8 Investigation (FBI).

9 **Section 3:** This Bill will be enforced by the Federal Bureau of  
10 Investigation (FBI) . A. No guns will be allowed to be sold u  
11 ntil a positive FBI background check is reported to the seller  
12 of the gun(s). B. This includes and is not limited to guns s  
13 old at gun shows, and privately between parties.

14 **Section 4:** This legislation will take effect on August 1, 2022.

15 **Section 5:** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby  
16 declared null and void.

## **A Bill to Ban Congressional Stock Trading**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:**

2 **Section 1:** Members of Congress and their immediate families shall  
3 no longer be able to participate in the trading of stocks while  
4 serving in office.

5 **Section 2:** Immediate family shall be defined as their spouse and  
6 dependent children.

7 **Section 3:** Implementation of this legislation will be overseen by  
8 the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC). Any member of  
9 Congress who is caught trading stocks shall have to pay a fine  
10 of one years salary and also pay all profits made from trading  
11 to the US Treasury.

12 **Section 4:** This legislation will take effect at the beginning of  
13 the fiscal year 2023.

14 **Section 5:** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby  
15 declared null and void.

## **A Bill to Standardize Death Certificates**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:**

2 **Section 1:** All states in the United States of America must adhere  
3 to the following for a standardized death certificate: A. A  
4 death cannot be automatically marked as any current virus even  
5 though it may have been a contributing factor on the death  
6 certificate. B. If a person died from Covid, Part I of the  
7 death certificate must only have Covid-19 as the primary cause  
8 of death. Part II can be left blank or a different condition  
9 can be written. However, if a deceased person had Covid-19 but  
10 their primary cause was different, then Covid-19 should only be  
11 written in Part II. If the cause of a person's death is  
12 undetermined, then in Part I, "unknown death" can be written.  
13 Medical Certifiers and hospitals must follow these procedures  
14 for every deceased person.

15 **Section 2:** Part I of a death certificate is the chain of the  
16 event(s) that caused the death. Part II of a death certificate  
17 are other significant conditions that possibly could have  
18 contributed to death but are not resulting in the underlying  
19 cause given in Part I.

20 **Section 3:** The Department of Health and Human Services in coalition  
21 with the Country Health Department will oversee the  
22 implementation of this bill. If the medical certifier in  
23 charge of writing the death certificate is caught mishandling  
24 the report and is committing fraud, they will be suspended from  
25 work for 6 months.

26 **Section 4:** This bill will be implemented on February 1st, 2022.

27 **Section 5:** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby  
28 declared null and void.
