

A Bill to Cut the Underbrush

1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:
2. **Section 1** All national parks shall be required to regularly clear the
3. underbrush from dense forest area.
4. **Section 2** The USDA's Forest Service and the Department of the Interior's
5. Bureau of Indian Affairs, Bureau of Land Management, Fish and Wildlife
6. Service, and National Park Service shall meet to form a new sub-committee
7. called the Wildfire Prevention Agency (WPA). This new agency determine the
8. correct clearing schedule for each national park.
9. **Section 3** The newly formed Wildfire Prevention Agency (WPA) will oversee the
10. enforcement of the bill.
11. **Section 4** This bill shall go into efect January 1st, 2023.
12. **Section 5** All other laws that are in conflict with this new policy shall
13. hereby be declared null and void.

A Bill to Require States to Test Water for Forever Chemicals

1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:
2. **Section 1** Upon passage of this bill, each state shall be required to conduct
3. water table testing for forever chemicals. The results of these tests
4. shall be made public immediately.
5. **Section 2** Forever chemicals are polyfluoroalkyl substances that make certain
6. products nonstick or stain resistant. These chemicals are often thought to
7. be dangerous.
8. **Section 3** The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) will oversee the
9. enforcement of the bill.
10. **Section 4** This bill shall go into effect November 1st, 2022.
11. **Section 5** All other laws that are in conflict with this new policy shall
12. hereby be declared null and void.
13. Introduced for Congressional Debate by SCJFL.

A Bill to Make Federal Voting Compulsory

1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:
2. **Section 1** All US citizens who are eligible to vote in federal elections shall
3. be required to do so.
4. **Section 2** State laws shall still govern the restriction of some voters (such
5. as those convicted of felonies or who are mentally incapacitated), but all
6. those citizens who are not in violation of state law are required to cast a
7. vote.
8. **Section 3** The Federal Election Commission shall oversee the enforcement of
9. the bill.
10. **Section 4** This bill shall go into effect beginning on January 1, 2024.
11. **Section 5** All other laws that are in conflict with this new policy shall
12. hereby be declared null and void.
