Best Practices for Online Competition

While most of us had never attended an online tournament before 2020, the past few years have taught us a few things about how to compete, judge, and run online tournaments effectively. We wanted to draw your attention to a few best practices:



Timing: Arrive to your video competition room early to give yourself time to make sure all your tech is working.



Cameras: Everyone, please have your cameras on to give visual feedback to the competitors. You should mute your mic when not presenting.



Empty room: If you are in an empty competition room, when you should have other competitors and judges, you may be in the wrong spot. Head to the help room.



Help Room: Bookmark the NOF Help Room link (available on FTN tournament homepage) where tournament staff will be available to assist if anything goes wrong.

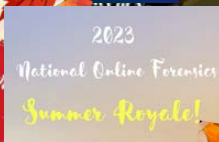
