Entry Procedure: Entries must be sent by using the [forensictournament.net](http://www.forensictournament.net) website: <http://www.forensictournament.net>. There is no separate division for novices. Instead, students entered in the novice division are eligible to receive a top novice award. All competitors will compete in a single open division. Drop Fees: A \$5 drop fee will be assessed after 5PM Tuesday, October 10th.

Events and Rules:

- 11 Individual events will be offered in open division only. A.F.A. Event Descriptions will apply. We will use A.F.A. style for impromptu.
- **Students may enter a maximum of two events per pattern.**
- **Students may not enter both IPDA and IE's. You must choose one or the other.**
- No material used in competition shall have been used by the student in intercollegiate competition prior to September 1, 2022.
- If Palomar students compete at the tournament, they will not be eligible for sweepstakes awards or points.
