

A Bill to Modernize American Road Infrastructure

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- 1 **SECTION 1.** The United States federal government will invest \$100 billion dollars into
2 American infrastructure with the purpose of improving the quality of roads
3 and highways.
- 4 **SECTION 2** The funding for this legislation will come from a federal gas tax hike of
5 \$0.25/gallon.
- 6 **SECTION 3.** The Department of Transportation will be in charge of implementation of
7 today's legislation. All additional revenue generated by this gas tax will be
8 given to subsidize the production of EV infrastructure including electric
9 vehicle chargers and increase federal rebates for the purchase of electric
10 vehicles.
- 11 **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall take effect on January 1, 2025
- 12 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Lower Drug Smuggling in America

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- 1 **SECTION 1.** Every year, over 20,000 pounds of Fentanyl are illegally transported into
2 the United States via the southern border. To combat this crisis, \$40 billion
3 of funding will be allocated to reduce drug smuggling into the United
4 States.
- 5 **SECTION 2** The \$40 billion in funding will be jointly allocated to Customs and Border
6 Patrol (CBP) and the Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA), with each agency
7 receiving \$20 billion. Funding may be used for, but is not limited to, the
8 following purposes:
- 9 A. Agent recruitment and retention
10 B. Surveillance along the southern border
11 C. Drug-detection technologies
- 12 **SECTION 3.** Administration of this bill will be overseen by the CBP and the DEA.
- 13 **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall take effect on January 1, 2025
- 14 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

1 **SECTION 1.** The Felony Check Boxes on job applications are to be banned, as to offer a
2 fair chance to all eligible applicants.

6 **SECTION 3.** The Department of Labor shall oversee the implementation of legislation
7 and the Federal Bureau of Investigation shall examine the effect on crime
8 rate and reincarceration rate.

10 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Increase Prices of Firearms

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- 1 **SECTION 1.** The United States of America shall attach a sumptuary tax to all firearm
2 sales. The sumptuary tax shall be determined by the states with all monies
3 divided equally between the states and federal government. In which the
4 bare minimum for the tax shall be 50%.
- 5 **SECTION 2** A firearm shall be defined as a weapon from which a shot is discharged by
6 gunpowder. Firearms include rifles, shotguns, pistols, revolvers, automatic
7 firearms, air guns, handguns, etc, and all projectiles associated with
8 firearms. A sumptuary tax shall be defined as an excise tax which
9 delineates the subject of the tax as representing a threat to society; a
10 sumptuary tax is often referred to by the colloquialism “sin tax” and has
11 been applied to tobacco, alcohol, and other undesirable subjects.
- 12 **SECTION 3.** The United States Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms and the
13 Internal Revenue Service will work together to oversee the enforcement of
14 this bill.
- 15 **SECTION 4.** Upon passage of this legislation, all prices and sumptuary taxes of firearms
16 must be updated within a week upon passage of this bill.
- 17 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

The No More Meat Act

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- 1 **SECTION 1.** The United States Congress shall gradually phase out all subsidies and
- 2 financial incentives to meat and dairy manufacturers. All funding currently
- 3 allocated to meat and dairy industries shall be redirected to fruit and
- 4 vegetable agriculture.
- 5 **SECTION 2** Subsidies to meat and dairy industries will be phased out by 20% each year,
- 6 to be fully reallocated 5 years after the date of enactment of this act.
- 7 **SECTION 3.** The implementation of this bill shall be overseen by the United States
- 8 Department of Agriculture.
- 9 **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall take effect on January 1, 2025
- 10 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
