5. **Section 2** "Recycling bins" are special bins used to collect things
6. like paper, plastic, and cans that can be made into new things
7. instead of being thrown away.

8. **Section 3** The Department of Education will make sure all schools
9. have enough recycling bins and will teach students and teachers
10. how to use them properly to recycle as much as possible.

11. **Section 4** This law will start on July 1, 2024. If any other rules
12. disagree with this one, those rules won't count anymore. All
13. other laws that are in conflict with this new policy shall
14. hereby be declared null and void.

9. plant these trees. They will pick the best types of trees that

10. are good for each city's weather and help take care of them so

11. they grow big and strong.

12. **Section 4** This law will start on July 1, 2025. All other laws that

13. are in conflict with this new policy shall hereby be declared
