

A Bill to Ensure Playgrounds Are Accessible to All Children

1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2. **Section 1** All public playgrounds in the United States must include
3. at least 50% of equipment designed to be accessible to children
4. with disabilities.

5. **Section 2** "Accessible equipment" includes ramps, swings with
6. harnesses, sensory-friendly features, and other structures usable
7. by children with physical, sensory, or developmental disabilities.

8. **Section 3** The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)
9. will oversee compliance and provide funding to assist local
10. governments with implementation.

11. **Section 4** This legislation will take effect on January 1, 2025.

12. **Section 5** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby
13. declared null and void.

A Resolution to Provide More Recycling Bins in Public Spaces

1. **WHEREAS**, Many public spaces lack adequate recycling options,
2. leading to increased waste; and
3. **WHEREAS**, Recycling reduces pollution and conserves natural
4. resources; and
5. **WHEREAS**, Placing more recycling bins in parks, streets, and malls
6. can encourage responsible waste disposal; now, therefore, be it
7. **RESOLVED**, That the Congress here assembled encourages local
8. governments to install recycling bins in all public spaces by
9. December 2025; and, be it
10. **FURTHER RESOLVED**, That the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)
11. offer grants to assist in funding these installations.

A Bill to Ban Single-Use Plastic Straws in Restaurants

1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2. **Section 1** All restaurants in the United States shall cease the use
3. of single-use plastic straws and provide paper, reusable, or
4. biodegradable alternatives instead.

5. **Section 2** Exceptions will be made for individuals who require
6. plastic straws due to medical conditions.

7. **Section 3** The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) will enforce this
8. policy and issue fines to non-compliant restaurants.

9. **Section 4** This legislation will take effect on January 1, 2026.

10. **Section 5** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby
11. declared null and void.
