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A Bill to Ban Single-Use Plastic Straws in Restaurants

1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2. **Section 1** All restaurants in the United States shall cease the use
3. of single-use plastic straws and provide paper, reusable, or
4. biodegradable alternatives instead.

5. **Section 2** Exceptions will be made for individuals who require
6. plastic straws due to medical conditions.

7. **Section 3** The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) will enforce this
8. policy and issue fines to non-compliant restaurants.

9. **Section 4** This legislation will take effect on January 1, 2026.

10. **Section 5** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby
11. declared null and void.

A Resolution to Reduce Food Waste in Grocery Stores

1. **WHEREAS**, Over 30% of food produced in the United States is wasted
2. each year; and
3. **WHEREAS**, Grocery stores can reduce food waste by donating unsold,

5. **WHEREAS**, Reducing food waste helps fight hunger and environmental
6. damage; now, therefore, be it
7. **RESOLVED**, That the Congress here assembled urges grocery stores to
8. partner with local charities to donate unsold food.

A Bill to Mandate Transparent Labeling on Packaged Foods

1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2. **Section 1** All packaged foods must clearly display information about
3. nutritional content, allergens, and potential environmental
4. impacts of production.

5. **Section 2** "Packaged food" is defined as any food item that is
6. pre-sealed by the manufacturer and sold to consumers in its final
7. form for consumption.

8. **Section 3** The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) will oversee
9. implementation and enforce penalties for false or incomplete
10. labeling.

11. **Section 4** This legislation will take effect on July 1, 2026.

12. **Section 5** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby
13. declared null and void.
