1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2. **Section 1** All public schools in the United States shall begin

3. classes no earlier than 8:30 AM to improve student health and

4. academic performance.

5. **Section 2** For the purposes of this bill: A. Public schools refer to

6. secondary schools funded by local, state, or federal

7. government. B. Student health includes physical, mental, and

8. emotional well-being as defined by the Department of Health and

9. Human Services.

10. **Section 3** The Department of Education will oversee implementation

11. of this policy. A. Schools failing to comply will face a

12. reduction in federal education funding proportional to the

13. number of violations. B. States successfully implementing the

14. policy within two years will receive priority for federal

15. educational grants.

16. **Section 4** This legislation will take effect in for school year

17. 2026-2027.

18. **Section 5** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby

19. declared null and void.

A Bill to Implement a Curfew for Teen Drivers

1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2. **Section 1** A national curfew shall be established for drivers aged
3. 16 to 18, prohibiting them from operating motor vehicles between
4. the hours of 10:00 PM and 5:00 AM unless accompanied by a
5. licensed driver aged 21 or older.

6. **Section 2** For the purposes of this bill: A. Drivers aged 16 to 18
7. refers to individuals who hold a valid learner's permit or
8. intermediate driver's license within this age range. B. Curfew
9. exceptions include cases of medical emergencies, school-related
10. events, or employment obligations, provided documentation is
11. available.

12. **Section 3** State Departments of Motor Vehicles (DMVs) will enforce
13. this policy. Violations will result in a \$100 fine for the first
14. offense, and repeat offenses will lead to a suspension of the
15. driver's license for 30 days.

16. **Section 4** This legislation will take effect on January 1, 2025.

17. **Section 5** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby
18. declared null and void.
