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A Bill to Ban Facial Recognition in Public Spaces

1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2. **Section 1** The use of facial recognition technology in public spaces
3. by law enforcement and private companies shall be prohibited.

4. **Section 2** For the purposes of this bill: A. Facial recognition
5. technology refers to software that identifies or verifies a
6. person's identity using facial features. B. Public spaces include
7. streets, parks, stores, stadiums, and other areas open to the
8. general public.

9. **Section 3** The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) and the Department of
10. Justice (DOJ) will oversee enforcement of this legislation. A.
11. Law enforcement agencies that violate this ban will face federal
12. funding reductions. B. Private companies that collect or use
13. facial recognition data in public spaces will face fines of up
14. to \$50,000 per violation.

15. **Section 4** This legislation will take effect on July 1, 2026.

16. **Section 5** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby
17. declared null and void.

9. to regulate deepfake technology and establish criminal penalties
10. for those who use it to harm others.
