1. **WHEREAS**, Artificial intelligence is being used to create music,
2. art, and writing that competes with human creators; and
3. **WHEREAS**, Many artists and writers are losing opportunities due to
4. AI-generated content flooding the market; and
5. **WHEREAS**, The widespread use of AI in creative industries may
6. devalue human artistic expression; now, therefore, be it
7. **RESOLVED**, That the Congress here assembled support regulations
8. limiting the use of artificial intelligence in professional
9. creative industries.

A Bill to Require Country of Origin Labeling on All Food Products

1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:
2. **Section 1** All food products sold in the United States shall be
3. required to display clear country-of-origin labeling.
4. **Section 2** For the purposes of this bill: A. Country of origin
5. labeling refers to labels that indicate where a product was
6. grown, raised, or produced. B. Food products include fresh
7. produce, meat, seafood, dairy, and packaged foods.
8. **Section 3** The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) shall oversee
9. enforcement. A. Retailers that sell unlabeled food products will
10. face fines of \$1,000 per violation. B. The USDA will assist in
11. certifying labeling accuracy to prevent false claims.
12. **Section 4** This legislation will take effect on January 1, 2027.
13. **Section 5** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby
14. declared null and void.
