

A Resolution to Limit Celebrity Political Endorsements

1. **WHEREAS**, Celebrities have a large influence on public opinion,
2. especially among young voters; and
3. **WHEREAS**, Political endorsements from celebrities can overshadow
4. important policy discussions; and
5. **WHEREAS**, Some people vote based on celebrity opinions rather than
6. facts or research; now, therefore, be it
7. **RESOLVED**, That the Congress here assembled encourage political
8. campaigns to limit the use of celebrity endorsements in elections.

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A Bill to Ban Surveillance Drones Over Private Property

1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

2. **Section 1** It shall be illegal for individuals, companies, or
3. government agencies to fly surveillance drones over private
4. property without the owner's consent.

5. **Section 2** For the purposes of this bill: A. Surveillance drones are
6. unmanned aerial vehicles equipped with cameras or sensors used to
7. observe or record. B. Private property refers to land owned by
8. individuals or businesses that is not open to the public.

9. **Section 3** The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) will oversee
10. enforcement. Violators may be fined up to \$10,000 per incident.

11. **Section 4** This legislation will take effect on July 1, 2026.

12. **Section 5** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby
13. declared null and void.
