Tyler Junior College is honored to have the opportunity to host the SECOND annual Regional V Championship Tournament for the newly aligned regions of Phi Rho Pi. This tournament will be ONLINE using the same software as the Phi Rho Pi Nationals: ForensicTournaments.Net. The dates are March 21-22, 2025 (unless we have so many entries that we need to go into Sunday, March 23rd.) The deadline for receiving entries is March 17th, 2025 by 5:00 p.m. CST. Changes may be made until March 19th, 2025 by 5:00 pm without additional charge. Please log into the FTN (Forensicstournament.net) to submit your entries (will be open before the end of February.) Since this is still a "new" tournament, it would be very helpful if you would email me a quick response and tell me if you are planning to attend so that I can do necessary preparations. No need for exact entries in this email, but telling me approximately how many Parli teams and IPDAers you have would be very helpful. And if you have LDers, let me know and we can add that event.

We'll have the **Coaches' Meeting and Students' Meeting** Friday, March 21st at 8:30 p.m. (CST) in Zoom Rooms TBA.

We will be running most IE events in two rounds with one judge in one round and two judges in the other. Finals will be held in events large enough to warrant them. Parli and IPDA will have 4 preliminary rounds. Semis will be held if entries are large enough, otherwise straight to finals.

Awards

All individual events will receive awards (medals) 1st through 6th place. There will also be first through sixth place speaker awards for Parliamentary Debate and 1st - 3rd speaker awards in IPDA. First through Third place plaques will be awarded for Sweepstakes in the following categories: Debate, I.E.s, Top Speaker and Overall. The Sherri Ryan White Award will also be given to the school with the highest cumulative sweepstakes points.

1st = 15 points

Semi Finalists not advancing = 3

Parli

1st = 20 points

2nd = 15 points

3rd = 10 points

Quarter Finalists not advancing = 5

All Changes must be made by March 19th by 5:00 pm. CST Changes made later will be charged entry fees plus \$25 for IEs and \$100 for Judge, IPDA and Parli drops.
