A Bill to Ban Phone Use While Walking in Crosswalks

1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:
2. **Section 1** It shall be illegal to use a mobile phone or wear
3. headphones while crossing the street in a marked crosswalk.
4. **Section 2** The law applies to all pedestrians over the age of 10.
5. Emergency calls are exempt from this rule.
6. **Section 3** Local law enforcement agencies will issue warnings for
7. first offenses and \$25 fines for repeat offenses.
8. **Section 4** This legislation will take effect on January 1, 2027.
9. **Section 5** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby
10. declared null and void.

A Resolution to Limit the Sale of Bottled Water in Public Parks

1. **WHEREAS**, Millions of plastic water bottles are thrown away each
2. year, adding to pollution and waste; and
3. **WHEREAS**, Many public parks already have water fountains or refill
4. stations available; and
5. **WHEREAS**, Limiting bottled water sales would encourage reusable
6. bottles and protect the environment; and
7. **WHEREAS**, Some people rely on bottled water when fountains are
8. broken or not clean; now, therefore, be it
9. **RESOLVED**, That the Congress here assembled encourage local
10. governments to limit the sale of bottled water in public parks
11. while expanding access to clean water fountains.

A Bill to Require Seat Belts on School Buses

1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:
2. **Section 1** All new school buses in the United States must be
3. equipped with seat belts for every passenger seat.
4. **Section 2** The Department of Transportation will oversee this rule
5. and ensure all manufacturers meet safety standards.
6. **Section 3** Schools that purchase buses without seat belts after this
7. law takes effect will lose access to federal transportation
8. funding.
9. **Section 4** This legislation will take effect on July 1, 2026.
10. **Section 5** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby
11. declared null and void.
