

A Resolution to Expand Draft Eligibility

1. **WHEREAS**, Current federal law requires men between the ages of 18
2. and 25 to register with the Selective Service System; and
3. **WHEREAS**, Women are permitted to serve in all military positions,
4. including combat roles; and
5. **WHEREAS**, Requiring only men to register raises questions about
6. whether the responsibilities of citizenship are being shared
7. equally; and
8. **WHEREAS**, Expanding registration would make millions of additional
9. citizens available if the United States were to reinstate a
10. military draft; now, therefore, be it
11. **RESOLVED**, That the Congress here assembled support requiring all
12. United States citizens between the ages of 18 and 25, regardless
13. of sex, to register with the Selective Service System.

A Bill to Tax Vacant Homes

1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:
2. **Section 1** An additional federal property tax shall be imposed on
3. residential homes that remain unoccupied for more than nine
4. months of a calendar year.
5. **Section 2** Homes undergoing major repairs, being actively sold, or
6. left vacant because their owners are serving in the military
7. shall be exempt from this tax.
8. **Section 3** The Internal Revenue Service will administer the tax.
9. Revenue collected will be used to support federal housing
10. assistance programs.
11. **Section 4** This legislation will take effect on January 1, 2028.
12. **Section 5** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby
13. declared null and void.
