



Hap Hingston Forensics Invitational 2011 Debate Restrictions & Judges

Restrictions

We have received a number of requests for schools to bring additional entries in debate. To reach a practical compromise, we have changed our restriction from 8 to 12 total debate entries per school. However, CX and Public Debate are still restricted to 8 entries for each event. For example, if you have 8 CX teams you may still enter a maximum of 4 additional teams in Public, Public Forum or LD.

If tournament entries in debate exceed our availability of rooms or judges, then we will impose “by rounds” to adjust things accordingly.

Judges

Requirements:

There was an error caught on the tournament invite regarding judging requirements for Public Forum. Since PF can be double flighted (two flights per scheduled round of competition) like LD, judging requirements have been adjusted according to the following guidelines:

Debate: one judge covers **two entries** in CX or PD, or **four entries** in PF or LD, or an equivalent combination therein.

Fees:

As a result of the shift in judging requirements, PF judging fees were adjusted from \$50 to \$25 per uncovered entry. Entry and Judging fees are now as follows:

School Fee:	\$ 30
LD Debater	\$ 10
CX Team	\$ 20
Public Debate Team	\$ 20
Public Forum Team	\$ 20
Individual Events	\$ 5

JUDGING FEES (per)

LD debater	\$ 25
CX Team	\$ 50
Public Debate team	\$ 50
Public Forum team	\$ 25
Individual Event	\$ 10
