You are invited to the 2nd annual Sedro-Woolley High School Invitational Wednesday afternoon and evening December 15, 2010. This year we are running a Individual Events Tournament. We will be using forensictournament.net to handle registrations. Please go to www.forensictournament.net, log in and create an account and follow the instructions to register by Monday, December 13th at 4:00 PM. Fees will be set at that time. Drops after that time should be emailed to smccartt@swsd.k12.wa.us or smccartt@comcast.net. *This will be a District One State Qualifying Tournament for the top finisher in each event.*

Tournament Schedule

We will be offering three IE rounds with no finals. We will be running Pattern A and Pattern B concurrently so double-booked contestants will have to let judges know that they are double-booked. We will be offering Extemp, Dramatic Interp, Duo Interp, Expos, Oratory, Impromptu, Humorous Interp, Interp Reading and Ed Comm.

Awards

Superior awards will be given to the top students and representatives.

Fees

\$30 school entry fee, \$9 per individual entry and \$15 per dual entry

Judging

One judge for every five (5) IE entries. Please bring judges! We do our best to find extras, but we rarely have enough to cover for schools which are short. If you need to hire a judge, please let me know as early as possible, and I will do my best to meet those needs.

Divisions

Open and Novice divisions available. Students may double enter at their own risk—the tournament is not responsible for missed rounds. Schools may enter a second squad if needed.

Events

Interp Reading—a scripted program using one or more pieces of prose AND one or more pieces of poetry around a theme. Author(s), title(s), and theme must be stated. Time: eight (8) minutes with 30 seconds grace.

Expository—a speech to inform. No more than 150 quoted words may be used. Visual aids may be used and notes may be used. Time: eight (8) minutes with 30 seconds grace.

Oratory—a speech to persuade. No more than 150 quoted words may be used. Time: ten minutes (10) minutes.

Dual Interp—contestants may choose their material from prose, poetry, or drama. Contestants may use one or more selections. Delivery must be from memory; props, costumes, and make-up are not permitted. Time: ten (10) minutes.

Dramatic Interp—a serious program of one or more selections of prose, poetry, or drama. Presentation must be from memory. Props, costumes, make-up are not permitted. Time: ten (10) minutes.

Humorous Interp—a humorous program of one or more selections of prose, poetry, or drama. Presentation must be from memory. Props, costumes, make-up are not permitted. Time: ten (10) minutes.

Impromptu—contestants will be given a choice of topics (a word, a quotation, a current event). The student will choose a topic and have six minutes to prepare and speak on the chosen topic. Time may be used in any manner the speaker chooses (example-2 minutes prep and 4 speaking or 4 minutes prep and 2 minutes speaking). Time: six (6) minutes.

Extemporaneous—Speaker is given three questions on current events. Speaker picks one question and has thirty (30) minutes to prepare a seven (7) minute speech. Speaker will be expected to organize and analyze relevant to the subject.
