The tournament allows large individual event entries which may force us to limit the number of schools attending, **so we recommend registering early**. Some reminders of importance: This is a non-smoking campus and food/drink (other than water) is not allowed outside the commons or judges lounge. These items will be confiscated and persons with them will be asked to leave. Additionally, you've done very well keeping the campus clean the last few years – please continue your tradition of showing respect for the campus, as this allows us to continue hosting the tournament! Thank you.

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION:

Registration is DIFFERENT this year: we are using ForensicsTournament.net to register. There are several advantages to this system:

- 1) It is entirely online
- 2) You can easily revise your entry / judges right up until cut-off
- 3) You have immediate verification that we've received the registration (you can see that your school is registered on the website)
- 4) It gives us, the tournament, one place to post update messages, results sheets, etc.
- 5) It saves us, the tournament, a ton of time doing data entry as it downloads all entries directly into the software that we use to run the tournament.

You'll need to do the following:

- 1) Register your school at ForensicsTournament.net
- 2) Find our tournament: <http://www.forensicstournament.net/ECMiddleSchoolSpeech/11>
- 3) Click on the "Register" tab.
- 4) Click "Competitors" to enter competitors. You will need to add each competitor individually the first time, but this information (if you remember / save your log-in info) will be retained by the website from year to year.
- 5) Click on "Judges" to enter judges. Use the check-boxes to indicate which rounds the judge is available. Use the text-box for additional comments / information, but please keep text comments brief.
- 6) You're all set! You can come back to this page at any time to see which other schools have entered, to modify your entry (including judges), to check for updates from the tournament, or to contact the tournament director.

LIMITATIONS:

Forty individual events slots per school. No Maximum entry per individual event.

DIVISIONS:

There will be two levels for individual events. Junior division is for all contestants in the sixth and seventh grades. Senior division is for sixth to eighth graders.

STUDENTS MAY NOT ENTER CONFLICTING EVENTS (ONLY ONE EACH PATTERN)

JUDGING:

Each COMPLETE Individual Events Judge covers 1-6 spots. Each event a speaker enters is considered a spot. Thus a speaker doing two events counts as 2 spots for judging. Thus four speakers doing two speeches each equal 8 spots and two judges. Please do not show up at the tournament without the required number of judges because it will force us to drop your contestants from competition. If you have 3 spots in Pattern A and 3 spots in Pattern B that = one judge. This is to give judges some rounds off. Judges need to understand that, even if they are parents, we cannot make dozens of special arrangements for rounds off. We'll try to give a judge a round off per pattern, but we need our judges to be available in order for us to run the tournament. This SINGLE most common reason that tournaments run late is that judges fail to pick up the ballots assigned to them or fail to return ballots in a timely fashion.

FEES:

There will be a \$15.00 school fee and each entry is \$8.00. **Each event again counts for one entry, thus a speaker doing two speeches costs \$16.00. A school with 6 entries would have a total fee of \$63.**

AWARDS:

Individual Events will award the top 10%+

CONFLICTING EVENTS:

Students **CANNOT** enter conflicting events in speech.

DEADLINES:

Registration on Forensicstournament.net is due on or before **TUESDAY, February 1st, by 4:00 P.M.** Fees will be set at that time and registration will be "locked" from further editing. After that time, email all registration changes to jwiegel@eastsidecatholic.org. Drops will not be removed from registration fees if they are post-deadline.

DIRECTIONS:

From Interstate-90 (heading east)

Take exit 15 (WA-900W/17th Ave NW toward Lake Sammamish State Park/Renton).

Turn left at 17th Ave NW/Renton Issaquah Rd SE.

Take the slight right on SE 56th Street.

Take left onto East Lake Sammamish Parkway.

Take right onto SE 43rd; go up hill and continue on road for about four miles past the Pine Lake shopping center. SE 43rd becomes 228th.

Follow 228th past Skyline High School.

Take right onto Crusader Way.

From 520

Take exit for Redmond Way/WA-202.

Keep right at the fork; follow signs for WA-202 E/Fall City/North Bend and merge onto Redmond Way/

Take right on Sahalee Way NE; Sahalee Way becomes 228th.

Follow for about two miles and take left on Crusader Way.

Eastside Catholic is located off of 228th Avenue and is set back about a 1/2 mile from the main road.

REGISTRATION WILL BE INSIDE THE LIBRARY, STUDENTS CAN GO DIRECTLY TO THE COMMONS AREA.

A LUNCHEON WILL AGAIN BE HELD FOR COACHES AND JUDGES IN THE LIBRARY TO WELCOME YOU TO OUR CAMPUS AND THANK YOU FOR YOUR COMMITMENT TO THIS ACTIVITY. We will again be asking your input for a better tournament.
