A Resolution to Eliminate School Districting in California

- WHEREAS: Students residing in the State of California are required to attend schools within their assigned school districts, and;
- WHEREAS: These schools may or may not be the first choice of parent's living within said districts, and;
- WHEREAS: Requiring a student to attend a specific school impinges upon a parent's right to choose, and;
- WHEREAS: The elimination of districting would allow a parent to send their student(s) to the school of his/her preference.
- THEREFORE: Be it resolved by this Student Congress here assembled that the State of California shall remove any and all reference to school districts.

A Bill to Ban Water Mining

- SECTION I: This bill, when enacted, will ban the practice of mining water by individuals, corporations or any other devised entity.
- SECTION II: Water mining shall be defined as the drilling of wells on either public or private property with the intent of selling said water to the general public.
- SECTION III: This bill does not restrict an individual property or corporation from drilling a well for personal use, only the sale of that water.
- SECTION III: The Department of the Interior will oversee the enactment of this bill.
- SECTION IV: This bill shall take affect immediately upon ratification.
