

A Resolution to Minimize the Use of Antibiotics in the Meat Industry

1. **WHEREAS**, Seventy percent of all antibiotics used in the United States goes to
2. food animal production; and
3. **WHEREAS**, The meat industry use antibiotics to promote the growth of cows and
4. pigs rather than to treat illnesses; and
5. **WHEREAS**, The overuse of antibiotics has led to the development of antibiotic
6. resistant microbes that kill over 100,000 people each year; now, therefore, be it
7. **RESOLVED**, That the Student Congress here assembled require that antibiotics
8. be used by the food industry only to treat sick animals; and, be it
9. **FURTHER RESOLVED**, all antibiotics used in the meat industry be administered
10. by a licensed veterinarian.

A Resolution Concerning a 4-day School Week

1. Whereas, A four-day school week would give more time for the students to study, and
2. Whereas, Most students do not have time to do a full school week with curricular activities and a
3. work week, and
4. Whereas, high school students could have a college schedule atmosphere, and
5. Whereas, The student's stress levels will reduce and they will have a chance to process
6. curriculum learned; therefore,
7. **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS ASSEMBLED THAT:**
8. All public schools must adapt a four day school week.

A Resolution Concerning Inheritance Tax
