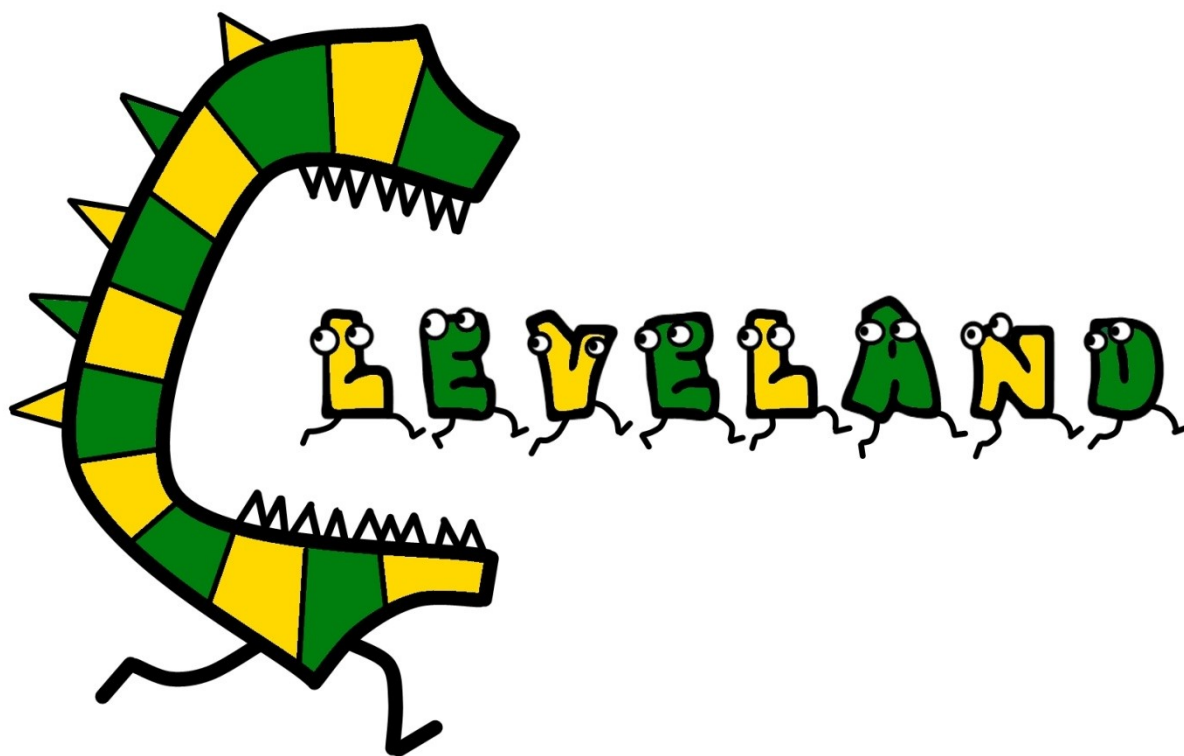




First Annual

Rules

We will be using OSAA state congress rules, in which all legislation is pre-submitted. We will provide copies of the legislation for competitors. In addition, each congress retains the right to suspend or change the rules in session.

Super Congress and Congress of the Absurd

Our first session will be a 2 hour preliminary round (4:00–6:00). Following a dinner break, we will post the names of those who have broken to Super Congress. Those who have not broken to Super Congress will reconvene at a Congress of the Absurd, where legislation that is crazy, absurd, funny, and outright weird is suggested. We will provide bills and resolutions for Congress of the Absurd (The USFG will build a Death Star, Oregon will secede from the union, et. Cetera.), but competitors are also encouraged to bring their own. Legislation for Congress of the Absurd does not need to be pre-submitted.
