The 2013 Glendale Warm-Up Speech and Debate Tournament

Greetings to all middle school speech and debate clubs and schools!

Glendale Community College, California and Wilshire Academy in association with the National Junior Forensic League are proud to announce our 2nd annual spring invitational tournament. Take a break from the winter cold and spend some time in sunny California. Glendale Community College is located just a short drive away from Hollywood, Disneyland, Six Flags Magic Mountain, Legoland, and dozens of other attractions, and, oh yeah... We're going to host a speech tournament, too!

To be clear, this tournament is not meant to be an alternative to the national championship tournament hosted by NJFL in June. Rather, this tournament is meant to encourage a healthy competition before nationals and provide an opportunity to sharpen competitive speeches before the championships. The tournament will begin on Saturday, April 14th, 2013! We're hoping to host many schools from outside the southern California area so that we might share our weather and provide a competitive tournament at the same time. Please feel free to pass this invitation along to anyone who might be interested in attending!

Accommodations:

Since a few local restaurants across footbridge from campus will be open, it is not advisable to drive to restaurants; the GCC campus is relatively isolated from the rest of the Glendale area. Your competitors may risk being late for their next round. If you would like food other than what is locally available, we recommend sending a coach or parent out for the food.

We have reserved a block of rooms at the Glendale Hilton for \$109 per night. These rooms will be available until March 22nd, but will be released after that date, so please make reservations early. While there are certainly other hotels available for a cheaper rate, some of them are not nearby the Glendale campus, and those that are nearby are aren't always the best in terms of quality.

Entries:

All of the typical NJFL events will be offered and the tournament will run using NJFL rules, with the slight modification of Original Oratory. This event will be split into two subcategories: Persuasive Original Oratory and Informative Original Oratory. We will provide three preliminary rounds for all speech events plus at least one final round (the schedule may need to adjust for semi rounds if entries warrant). All debate rounds will have five preliminary rounds and outrounds will be dictated by NJFL standards. Congress will consist of three preliminary rounds with a single final round.

***To ensure that the tournament starts on time and runs smoothly, we are instituting a \$25 nuisance fee for any/all judges who do not check in at the judge's table 15 minutes before the first round.** Please let your judges know the times for the first round for **both days**, as we will definitely be instituting this fine. Please note that many teams who switch judges at the last minute fail to notify the new judge of this fine.
