Events:

PATTERN A: Extemporaneous, Persuade, POI, Drama, Comm Analysis

PATTERN B: Impromptu, Informative, Prose, Duo, After-Dinner, Poetry

All competitors are limited to two events per IE pattern. All IEs are offered in Open and Novice Divisions.

PATTERN C: Novice & Open Parliamentary Debate: NPDA Rules, No Warm Room

Novice & Open IPDA Lincoln Douglas Debate: IPDA Rules

All competitors are limited to one debate event.

NOVICE Division: Novice division should be reserved for students with little or no experience. In general, a novice division competitor will be in his or her first full year in collegiate forensics, and will not have won more than three first, second or third place trophies in collegiate competition. Coaches should refrain from placing students with significant high school experience in novice divisions.

Sweepstakes:

1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place Team Sweepstakes (combined debate and speech) will be awarded, based on the following:

Debate: Schools will be awarded 1 point for each preliminary win in Debate; Silver teams will receive 10 points and Gold teams will receive 12 points

IEs: Schools will be awarded 6 points for 3rd, 8 points for 2nd, and 10 points for 1st in each individual event

Awards:

Awards will be presented to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in all IEs. Novice awards will be given in collapsed events. Up to half the field, using NPDA guidelines will advance to the Gold Round, where silver and gold awards will be contested. The Top Ten Speakers in each division and format of debate will be recognized.
