ACTIVITIES/GRUB:

The first half of the competition is as famous as Wild Bill Hickok for havin' all sorts of fun an' games. It's always a surprise what the cowboys and cowgals will come up with, but more'n likely you'll have a scavenger hunt, a piñata or two, and plenty of things to keep yerself occupied. Plus, we'll have our saloon girls teach y'all how to line dance. More importantly, we'll have plenty of food, so you can enjoy the festivities instead of leavin' town. But, if yer bellybutton starts gnawin' at yer backbone, there's plenty of to be had right across the street at some local eateries.

ACCOMMODATIONS:

The swing tournament will be held Feb. 8-10, 2013. The first half of the swing will be held at Glendale Community College on Friday and Saturday, and the second part will take place on Sunday at CSULA. The campuses are located

about ten miles away from one another, and many hotels are near to both. Because so many of the rooms we reserved in previous years went unused, we are not providing room blocks, however, if your team is traveling from out of town, we may still be able to help. Just ask!

ENTRIES:

We will again offer NFA-LD, with the prelims and finals to be held on Friday, Feb. 10th. **The Sunday portion of the tournament will also host a one day NFA-LD tournament, thus making it a swing NFA-LD weekend!** This year, we will also offer **Parliamentary Debate** with rounds to also begin on Feb. 10th. Saturday and Sunday will follow two-round IE swing schedules, with finals for each pattern. Triple entries are allowed in Open, double entries allowed in Novice. **Open ADS will have THREE prelim rounds on Saturday (see below for more information).**

All Entries **MUST** be received no later than Wednesday, February 6 at NOON PST (Fees are computed at that time) through www.forensicstournament.net.

DIVISIONS:

We will provide a Novice Division in all events with at least 10 Novice contestants. Otherwise, we will award a "Top Novice" speaker at the awards ceremony. Coaches must identify novices at the time of entry. A novice competitor is any student who has attended 3 or fewer tournaments.

AWARDS:

Awards will be provided for all finalists, including sweepstakes for the top three colleges and a top community college award. We plan to have both a open and novice division in all debates.

Congratulations to last year's ADS winner, Nathaniel Hawthorne. We have named the award after DeYoung, therefore, it is now called the Connor-Connor-DeYoung-Hawthorne Award. Let your students know that this year's winner will add his/her name to the award, to make it the Connor-Connor-DeYoung-Hawthorne-[Insert Your Student's Name Here] ADS Award in 2013. Please assist us in supporting this tradition by encouraging your students to showcase AFA qualified ADS-es at the Saturday portion of the swing for a chance to secure their name in Golden Cowboy lore. As a result of this special feature, ADS will have 3 prelim

rounds on Saturday, each round will have two judges. Additionally, the final round of ADS will have five judges and will be videotaped (finalist teams will have a free DVD mailed shortly after the competition). Please let the tournament staff know ahead of time if you do not wish for your student(s) to be videotaped.

Additionally, please ensure that you have entered the correct judges for the correct dates. Nuisance fees may be applied if promised judges are not on time; switching judges is the easiest way to mess that up. We don't want your money... We want your judges. That's why.**
