- Cost:** \$20 per debate (CX,LD,PF) entry, \$10 per IE/Congress entry. No squad fees.
(EdComm and SPAR entry is free for any student entering another event... \$10 otherwise)
A full fee schedule will be available on the FT.net website on January 29.
- Events:** 2 divisions in (Open/Novice) debate events (CX, LD, PF). Open division only in Congress and IEs.
EDCOMM & SPAR included.
- Rounds:** 3 guaranteed IE rounds – 4 in most events. Semis, or Finals breaks based on entry numbers.
5 guaranteed Debate rounds – 6 in most events. Hidden Quarters, Broken Semis and Finals.
6 hours Congress debate guaranteed. 4 hour Super Congress (Finals).
- Awards:** All students advancing to a break round will receive an award. Additional places may be awarded at the discretion of the tournament director.
- Judges:** Teams are required to provide a judge for every 2 CX entries, every 3 LD and PF entries, and every 5 IE entries. 1 scorer per Congress team is required.
- Oral Critique:** Judges are encouraged to keep their remarks brief at the end of the round. Judges must write comments on the ballot, including an RFD. Ballots marked "Oral RFD" or similarly incomplete will be returned to the judge until completed. Failure to pick up a ballot for the next round because you filed an incomplete ballot will be penalized accordingly.
- Food:** Food will be available on site for purchase by students. Judges' and coaches' food is provided free.
