



CAL T1 will have a special category for video submission of Original Narrative and Slam Poetry, and Original Oratory. Students can register for this event on Forensicstournament.net .

This event will follow the same guidelines as the speeches presented in person at the tournament. Please see the event guide on Forensicstournament. The purpose of allowing video submissions is to give students the opportunity to obtain experience with mediated communication and allow students who cannot attend the tournament a chance to participate. Students may enter video submissions and also enter the in-person events on September 30. Use of the same speeches in video and in the in person tournament is permitted and encouraged.

Winners will be announced on September 30 at the awards ceremony for CAL Tournament 1.

Videos are due by September 27.

Videos can be uploaded to YouTube or Vimeo but **must** be shared with ACLAForensics@gmail.com on or before September 27.

- Academy's name
- Student's grade level
