There will be 6 preliminary rounds and an appropriate number of elimination rounds, as well as awards for finalists and top speakers. We will also provide coffee and snacks all day for participants.

We hope to see you this November for the fifth running of a growing addition to the West Coast WUDC Debate Tournament Circuit.

Registration, Fees, Judging, and Rules

Please register for the tournament via www.forensicstournament.net. There is a fee of \$70 per team, and \$20 per school. Cash or check made out to “Dominican University of California” only please.

Each school is required to bring at least one judge that will be committed to serving through all preliminary rounds. Schools with multiple teams participating are required to bring additional judges according to the “N-1” formula (e.g., a school with N number of teams must bring N-1 number of judges). Please contact us as soon as possible if you are having trouble fulfilling the judging requirement. We will have to assess a charge of \$120 per non-covered team for schools unable to fulfill the judging requirement.
